NURSING FOOT CARE LEVEL I HLT7119

This course is designed to provide relevant theoretical instruction and practical experience in foot care for Registered Nurses and Registered Practical Nurses to become Foot Care Nurses. This level studies the foot, and addresses the etiology, treatment and prevention of common foot problems including structural abnormalities, nail pathology and skin/tissue (soft) disorders. Infection control is highlighted throughout the course. The uses of and practice with basic foot care instruments are part of this learning experience.

Notes: A copy of current registration as an RN or RPN with the College of Nurses must be presented to the instructor at the first class. Students practise on each other and therefore should not cut their toenails for at least four weeks prior to the course. Please remove nail polish. Text included. Instructor: Elizabeth Kelly

NURSING FOOT CARE LEVEL II HLT7118

This course explores advanced foot care for the high risk foot. This includes the study of risk factors and treatment plans for various disorders, including those clients with circulatory or neurological disorders and those with diabetes. Foot assessment and charting are practised and client teaching addressed. Foot health is discussed and students practise basic foot care in the classroom. New tools and their practical use in foot care are introduced in this level.
